Thanks to the generosity of the San Antonio Bar Foundation, the children and young adults in Bexar County now enjoy safer and more peaceful schools. In the six years since the AIM Program was initiated, the accomplishments include:

95 schools with AIM Peer Mediation programs
7,626 students trained as mediators
4,549 mediations conducted
9,852 participants in mediations as disputants
4,193 agreements, for a 96% success rate
3,364 attendees at AIM conflict resolution seminars

98% of participants stated that mediation created a more
positive school environment
87% stated that peer mediation has
reduced the number of disciplinary incidents
86% stated that school
staff has spent less time on disciplinary incidents.
